

## The Dogs on Lead Order, Seascale beach and adjacent car park, Seascale



Council has had byelaws in place

Categories:

1. Failing to remove dog faeces.
2. Not keeping a dog on a lead.
3. Not putting, and keeping, a dog on a lead when directed to do so by an authorised officer.
4. Permitting a dog to enter land from which dogs are excluded.

Failure to clean up after your dog has fouled may result in a fixed penalty fine of £80, which you are given 14 days to pay. Failure to pay a fixed penalty, or if people are caught re-offending, will result in further action being taken in the Magistrates court where a maximum fine of £1,000 plus costs can be imposed. This legislation can be enforced by the Appointed Persons or Police Community Support Officers.
