

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (FOOTPATH NO.426009 IN THE PARISH OF SEASCALE)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2018

WHEREAS the County Council of Cumbria (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) being the traffic authority for Footpath No.426009 in the Parish of Seascale is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said road should be restricted by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public and for works being proposed to be executed near the road (“the Works”).

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of their powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order.

1. No person shall proceed along the entire length of Footpath No. 426009 in the Parish of Seascale.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply other than at such times and to such extent as is indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty first day of March 2018 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Footpath No.426009 in the Parish of Seascale) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2018.
