

Gosforth and Seascale Car Parks

Following discussions between representatives of Sellafield Ltd and Gosforth and Seascale Parish Councils relating to inappropriate parking behaviours in and around the villages, the following measures will be implemented:

Employees of Sellafield Ltd and our Supply Chain (Contractors) will be reminded that the use of the bus shuttle services from Gosforth and Seascale are **only** for the use of those lodging/staying in the villages or residents of these two communities.

To reinforce this requirement, we are introducing a token system from Monday the 6 March 2023.

Proof of residency will be required before any tokens are issued.

The 3-week introductory period is to give people adequate time to apply and be issued with a token.

From the 6 March, if you are not in possession of a token, individuals will not be allowed on any of the shuttle buses.

Additionally, to better manage and control the leased bays on Seascale car park, Sellafield will be issuing a car park token for users to display in their vehicles.

To further deter adhoc shuttle services between Seascale and the Sellafield site, Calder Gate will be closed to all contractor crew buses and vehicles until further notice.

Sellafield Ltd is still actively exploring a location for a car park facility south of the site.

In the meantime, Employees travelling from the south of the site can apply for a Yottenfews single occupancy token (YOVA) until further parking south of site is available.
